<p>Exodus 3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses receives his commission from God on Mount Horeb. 	
<p>Exodus 4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God gives Moses 3 signs - Moses deficiency at speech and God's provision of Aaron, his brother - God instructs Aaron to go into the wilderness to meet Moses in the mount - Aaron receives all of the words of God from Moses and all of the signs. - Moses and Aaron gathered the elders of Israel and Aaron spoke all of the words of God, showed the signs and the people believed and humbly worshiped God. 	
<p>Exodus 7 - 8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses and Aaron go before Pharaoh - Aaron demonstrates the 1st sign - The magicians did in like manner - The rod of God swallows up the others - Pharaoh's heart was hardened - First three plagues upon the Egyptians and the children of Israel
