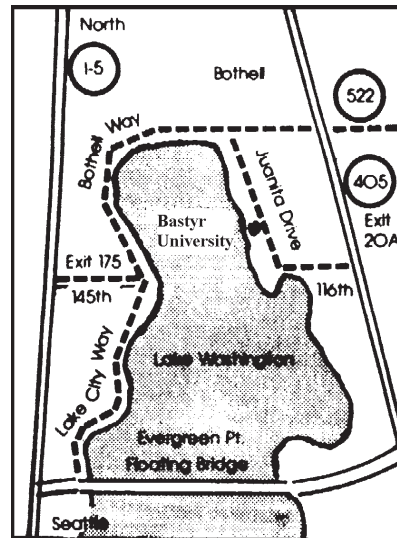
DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS

From I-5

(NORTHBOUND or SOUTHBOUND)
Exit at 145th Street NE (Exit 175). Drive east on 145th Street NE about 1.5 miles to Lake City Way. Turn left and drive north on Lake City Way (becomes Bothell Way) about 3 miles to 68th Avenue NE in Kenmore. Turn right and drive south on 68th Avenue NE (becomes Juanita Drive) about 1.5 miles to the entrance of Bastyr College on the right.

From I-405

(NORTHBOUND **ONLY**)
Exit at 116th Street NE (Exit 20A). Drive west on 116th Street NE about 1.5 miles to 98th Avenue NE. Cross 98th Avenue NE and continue west on Juanita Drive for about 4 miles to the entrance of Bastyr University on the left.
